RESTORATION IN THE MARION CHAPEL AT VISITATION CHURCH

Located in the Marion Chapel of Visitation Church (visitation church-la.com) facing the schoolyard, this stained exauisite glass panel was unfortunately struck by a ball and the elaborate center piece was broken. Ancient Arts

(wwwAncientArtsStainedGlass.com) owner Mark Schoem had worked with Visitation Church many times over the years and we were called again when this unfortunate incident occurred. Because of the shape of the center image the entire intricate small panel of 58 pieces had to be completely disassembled in order to incorporate the replacement piece. Once the best replacement glass was located, the blue center piece required etching, staining, painting and firing in order to match the original as closely as possible. The panel was successfully re-installed in January, 2017.

OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, EL MONTE, CA

Extensive stained glass repairs and restorations were carried out for Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church over a two month period between October and December of 2015. Of the eleven large stained glass windows in the Sanctuary, three were repaired in place. Seven panels requiring more extensive restoration, including one requiring the replacement of a missing inscription were removed to our studio in San Pedro. Replacement glass was located to match the missing and broken pieces as closely as possible. It was a pleasure working with Fr.William Rodriguez and his dedicated staff.
